









APPLY FOR A STUDY PERMIT

Students who are not Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada require a study permit issued by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) to study in a program that is longer than six months. Please check the IRCC website to learn more about study permit application and requirements.

EDUCATIONAL DOCUMENTS AND ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

All applicants to SAIT must demonstrate English language proficiency prior to admission, including students educated in Canada.

PAY DEPOSIT

Once you are offered admission, please accept your offer and pay your tuition deposit so you can receive your letter to apply for a study permit. Your tuition deposit goes to your tuition balance.

GET READY FOR YOUR FIRST DAY OF CLASSES

Once you've been admitted to your program, be sure to accept your offer and pay your tuition deposit. Next, you'll register for your courses, pay your tuition, apply for scholarships and awards, and apply for residence if you'd like to live on campus. 


GET YOUR POST-GRADUATION WORK PERMIT AND A JOB

Upon graduation from a SAIT designated learning program with a minimum of eight months in length, international students are eligible to apply for an open post-graduation work permit. This permit will allow graduates to work for any employer.

Understanding admissions requirements.

SAIT admission requirements are based on the Alberta curriculum and its equivalencies. Regardless of where a student attended high school (secondary school), **SAIT will evaluate each student's credentials and give course equivalencies under the Alberta curriculum.**



GENERAL GUIDELINES INCLUDE

- "30 level" courses under the Alberta curriculum are equal to Grade 12 or senior level
- "20 level" courses under the Alberta curriculum are equal to Grade 11 or junior level
- "10 level" courses under the Alberta curriculum are equal to Grade 10

The Alberta curriculum differentiates higher and lower level courses with dashes. Courses listed as "30-1" are considered the highest, while "30-2" courses are considered a lower level.

MEETING ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All full-time programs have specific admission requirements that you must meet to qualify for admission. All applicants must demonstrate English language proficiency, including students educated in Canada.

If you do not meet the admission requirements, consider enrolling in SAIT's upgrading program(s):

- English Language Foundations program to meet the English language proficiency requirement
- Academic Upgrading program to obtain any core academic subjects (math, physics, chemistry, biology) required for program admission.

EARLY ADMISSION

It is important to know when applications open and close prior to submitting your application. Visit **sait.ca** to confirm dates.





INTERNATIONAL DOCUMENT ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENT



If you were educated outside of Canada, you will require an international document assessment to ensure you've met the admission requirements for your program.

SCAN YOUR ORIGINAL HIGH SCHOOL AND/OR POST-SECONDARY DOCUMENTS IN COLOUR, AND ALSO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:



Secondary and/or post-secondary transcripts, mark sheets and examination results



Secondary diploma or graduation certificate and/or post-secondary degree



Explanation of grading scale (often found on the back or front page of transcripts)



If your documents were not issued in English, you must provide **certified translations** and the original documents (in original language). Refer to the Association of Translators and Interpreters of Alberta (ATIA) to find a certified translator



Your transcripts must show at least **three years of consecutive education** (secondary and/or post-secondary)



If your name has changed, we will require **validation of name change** (marriage certificate, etc.)

If you have documents from your respective country, you must include additional information.



ABOUT ELF

- ELF is a five-level program. Eeach level has two courses — one in reading and writing (COMN), and the other in listening and speaking (SPCH).
- Six start dates per year (eight-week terms)
- Full and part-time studies; evening and weekend courses available
- Intensive, skills-focused approach
- Proficiency-based placement and advancement
- Completion of ELF 5 is accepted in lieu of English-30 for most programs at SAIT

ABOUT ELF HYFLEX

- The ELF HyFlex course delivery allows students to join classes in-person or online from anywhere in the world.
- The ELF HyFlex course delivery allows students who wish to start their language program from their home countries while awaiting their study permit approval.
- The ELF HyFlex course delivery allows students to study English language from any part of the world without the requirement of in-person attendance.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The International Centre provides assistance to international students interested in studying at SAIT. International students can take the English Language Foundations program in preparation for SAIT career programs.

IS THIS THE RIGHT FIT FOR ME?

Progress in the ELF program depends on the student's demonstration of proficiency. Instructors regularly assess student progress through classroom assignments, participation and examinations. Students who achieve a rating of 50% (D) in all subjects can be recommended for promotion to the next level.

ELF is a fast-track program. Students should be prepared to dedicate considerable time to study and actively use their English outside of class time. SAIT career programs require academic appropriate English skills in all areas: reading, writing, listening and speaking.

CAREER PATH

English Language Foundations and Business Administration Plus is a new admission option that allows international applicants who meet the academic requirements to the Business Administration diploma but do not meet the minimum English language proficiency requirements.

Qualified applicants will complete the ELF portion of their studies and upon completion of the appropriate ELF level 5 will transition to Business Administration program.


