





As a government-funded public college, if you live here, your tuition is subsidized by the province of New Brunswick. It's why our tuition fees are only \$3,380 per academic year for domestic students. If you're an international student, tuition is just \$9,468, one of the most affordable in all of Canada.

I'M ACCEPTED, NOW WHAT?



WOOHOO! CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR ACCEPTANCE. HERE IS WHAT YOU NEED TO DO NEXT

First things first. Activate your Student Self-Service Account and confirm your seat by paying the confirmation fee. This will secure your seat.

If you are not a Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada, you will need a valid postsecondary study permit to attend NBCC for longer than six months. Apply as soon as you receive your letter of acceptance. The times needed to process your application may vary among visa offices.

Start budgeting and planning your finances. A college education is a smart investment, and it is never too early to start thinking about how you will pay for it. We've got a handy list of financial supports that are available to help. Check out **nbcc.ca/paying-for-college**


