Go to educationplannerbc.ca to submit your online application along with your supporting documents.

MAKE THE TUITION PAYMENT

Once accepted, follow the steps in the letter to submit any outstanding documents and make the tuition deposit payment to secure your seat in the program.

APPLY FOR STUDY PERMIT

Submit your study permit application together with Letter of Acceptance.

Minimum Admission Requirements

- 18 years of age prior to or within the first term of study
- High school graduation or equivalent
- Meet the minimum English proficiency requirement (see below)
- Post-graduate programs require successful completion of minimum 3-year degree from a recognized post-secondary institution
- Other academic and admission requirements for your chosen program (for example: Grade 11 math)

Do I need a counselor/agent?

If you are from India, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Philippines, Nepal, Sri Lanka or Nigeria, you are required to work with an NIC authorized agent. To find an agent, visit www.international.nic.bc.ca
